Federal contracts

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WASHINGTON - The following are the federal contracts awarded in Alabama during the week of April 24-30:

The Navy awarded a \$6.13 million contract to Future Research Corp., Huntsville, for laptop computers, associated accessories and integrated services to support the DOD Joint Technical Data Initiative. The contract was awarded by the Naval Inventory Control Point, Philadelphia.
