The following are federal contracts awarded in Alabama during the week of Sept. 25-Oct. 1:

#### Huntsville area

The Army awarded a \$24 million contract to Future Research Corp., Huntsville, for custom programming, software and systems engineering, and operation and maintenance services. The contract was awarded by the Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg, Miss.
